Book Review

YA novel Toxic by Lydia Kang is a unique blend of science fiction, horror, suspense, and romance. With alternating perspectives and two complex leads, Kang's descriptive but genuine prose creates an engaging futuristic universe with unexpected plot twists as the characters struggle to survive in a quarantined ship adrift in the cold vacuum of space.

The story revolves around the sentient ship, *Cyclo*, and its rapidly declining health. A four person crew is sent to evaluate and excavate the bio-hazardous ship and then die along with it in order for their loved ones to receive monetary benefits. Part of this crew is Fenn, a young boy ready and willing to die so his many mistakes can be atoned, and so sister's medical treatments can be paid for.

Upon arriving at the supposedly abandoned *Cyclo*, however, the crew finds Hana, a young woman who had been conceived illegally on the ship and hidden from the ship's residents her entire life. The only ones who knew of her existence were her mother and *Cyclo*. Hana's existence complicates matters, but she becomes the least of Fenn's worries as *Cyclo* continues to fall apart and the circumstances
