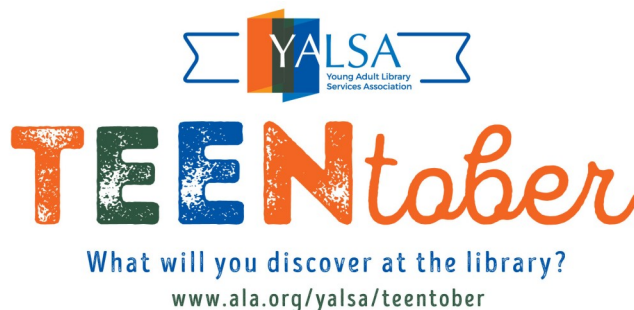
A thank you to all the members of the Friends of McCord Library, the volunteers, and those who support us.
