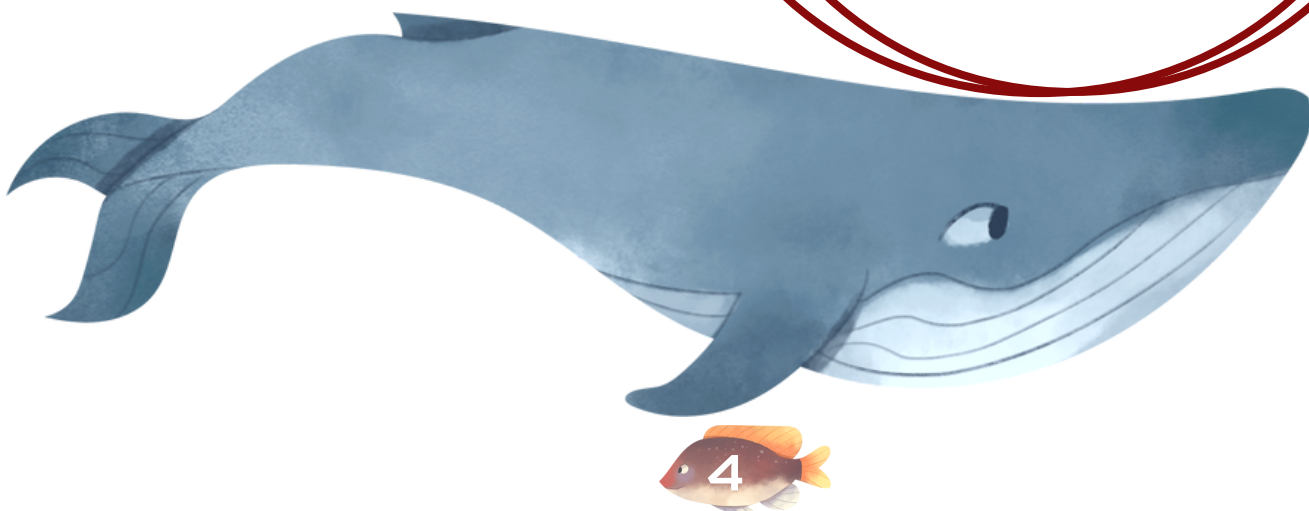

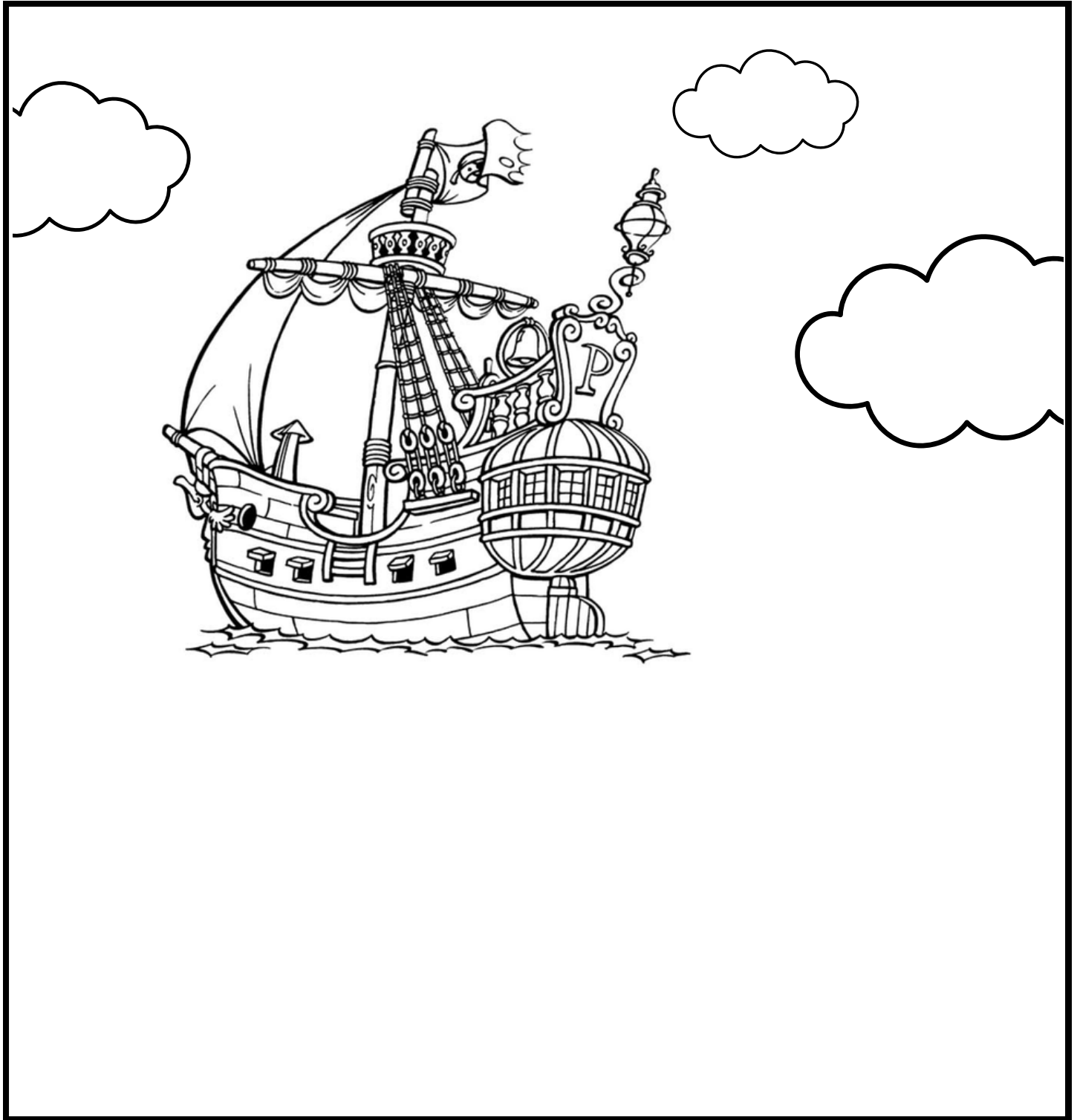

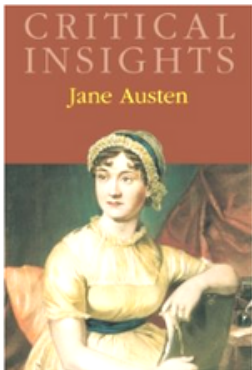


## The Kid-Friendly ADHD & Autism Cookbook by Pamela J. Compart and Dana Laake

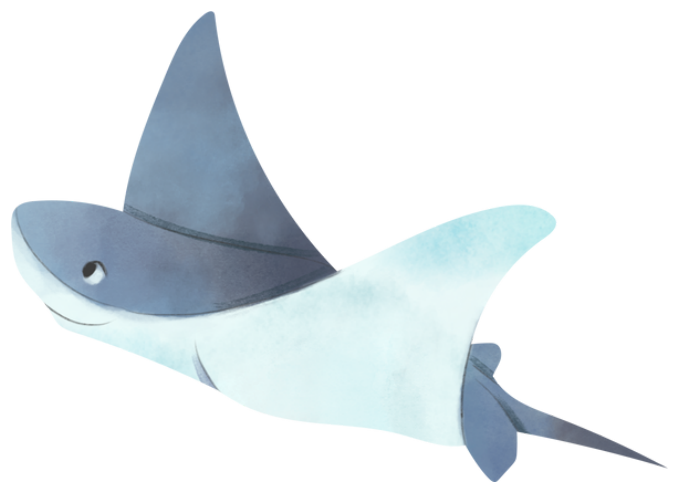
