

Sugarplum Saturday Activities 2022

Washi Tape

Supplies needed

- Double-sided tape
- Wrapping paper
- Scissors

Directions

1. Peel one side of your double-sided tape or peel from roll
2. Tape the sticky side to the back of your wrapping paper
3. Leave the backing on your double-sided tape!
4. Trim the wrapping paper around your tape



Easy Bow

Supplies needed

- Clear tape
- Wrapping paper
- Scissors

Directions

1. Cut a long rectangle of wrapping paper 9 in X 3 in.
2. Fold the wrapping paper in half (rectangle should now be 4.5 in X 3 in)
3. Draw a fish shape on your wrapping paper (see image 1) and cut out. Make sure to leave enough space for the center of your bow.
4. Open your fish.
5. Cut a slit on the bottom of one fish tail and the top of the other fish tail (see image 2)
6. Slide the slits together and push flat
7. Add another bit of wrapping paper around the center and tape

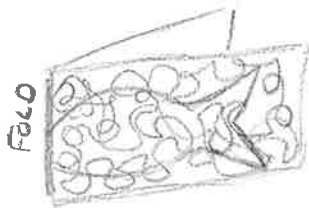

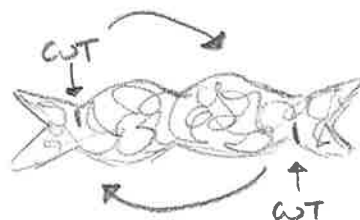
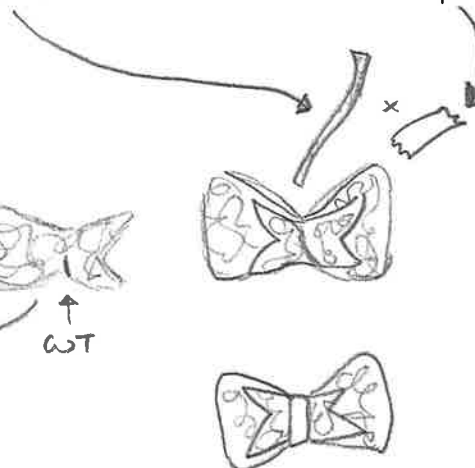

Gift Bow

Supplies needed

- Clear tape
- Wrapping paper
- Scissors
- Stapler

Directions

1. Cut your strips of wrapping paper. You need: 3 long strips $9\frac{1}{2}$ in X $\frac{3}{4}$ in, 3 medium strips $8\frac{1}{2}$ in X $\frac{3}{4}$ in, 1 small strip $6\frac{1}{2}$ in, and 1 tiny strip $2\frac{1}{2}$ in (see image 1)
2. Fold each strip in half to find the center
3. Following image 2, fold the end of one of the longest strips to the center then repeat on the opposite side. Tape. Repeat for all 3 long strips.
4. Once all three long strips are complete, assemble as in image 3.
5. Repeat for the medium strips then arrange and staple to long strips as shown in image 4
6. Fold the small strip as you folded the long and medium strips & tape together
7. Tape the ends of the tiny strip together (see image 5)
8. Make 2 tape donuts and tape the tiny strip to the small strip then tape both to the medium and long strips. (see image 6)

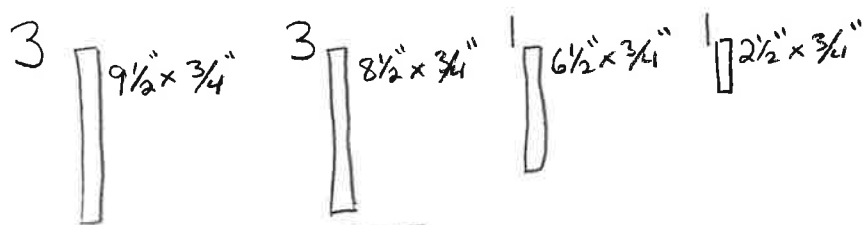
